The course allows you to self-select modules on safety leadership, focusing on strategic risk, incident investigation, and implementing safety governance for business success which seems as though it will really help professionals to become more effective at leading at a strategic level, as well as helping them to engage and influence with gravitas.

Are there any alternatives?

Alternatively of course, the NEBOSH (National Examination Board in Occupational Safety and Health) is a globally recognised awarding body based in the UK. NEBOSH courses provide in-depth technical knowledge of occupational health and safety and have been available for many years. The NEBOSH General Certificate is ideal for managers and supervisors, while the NEBOSH Diploma is a door opener to senior roles and also supports progression toward IOSH Chartered membership. Health and safety professionals are in huge demand, and the market is competitive and fast moving. Regulatory requirements are evolving, workplace risks are increasing, and organisations need leaders who can ensure that the company is future fit, able to anticipate challenges and deliver solutions.
